Do not attempt to neutralize with chemical agent. Do not use any oils or ointments. Seek medical attention as soon as possible. Skin – If allergies develop, discontinue use. Inhalation – Vaporization is unlikely to occur, however, if it does, immediately remove victim to fresh air. Obtain medical attention as soon as possible if there are signs or breathing difficulties. Ingestion – Do not induce vomiting since aspiration into the lungs may cause lipoid pneumonia.
